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
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FROZEN LIGHTS

The Frozen Lights company specialise in theatre for young adults and adults with learning disabilities. The production was produced and supported through National lottery funding through Arts Council England.

The theme was the futuristic world 2065, where life is being controlled by an oppressive regime. The story follows a group of rebels who live outside the system and believe things can change for the better. They live in hope of a return to a time where music is allowed ; a return to justice and freedom. The performances were jam packed with interaction, audience participation, music, signing and exploration. Students all had an amazing time developing their communication skills and getting the opportunity to explore new experiences out in a community setting.

We hope to take part in more live theatre with Frozen lights in the future.





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
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CHRISTMAS MARKET
